

The Code of Administrative Offences of the Russian Federation No. 195-FZ dated December 30, 2001 (as amended on November 22, 2016)

Article 15.21. Illegal Use of Insider Information

(as amended by the Federal Law No. 224-FZ dated July 27, 2010)

The illegal use of insider information, unless this action constitutes a criminal offense,

shall be punishable with an administrative fine for citizens in the amount of RUB 3,000 to 5,000; for officials in the amount of RUB 30,000 to 50,000 or disqualification for a period of one to two years; for legal entities in the amount of the excessive income or the aggregate losses avoided by the citizen, official or legal entity as a result of the illegal use of insider information, for a total of no less than RUB 700,000.

Note. In this Article and in Article 15.30 of this Code, “excessive income” means income defined as the difference between the income that has been received as a result of illegal actions and the income that would have been received without the illegal actions referred to herein.
