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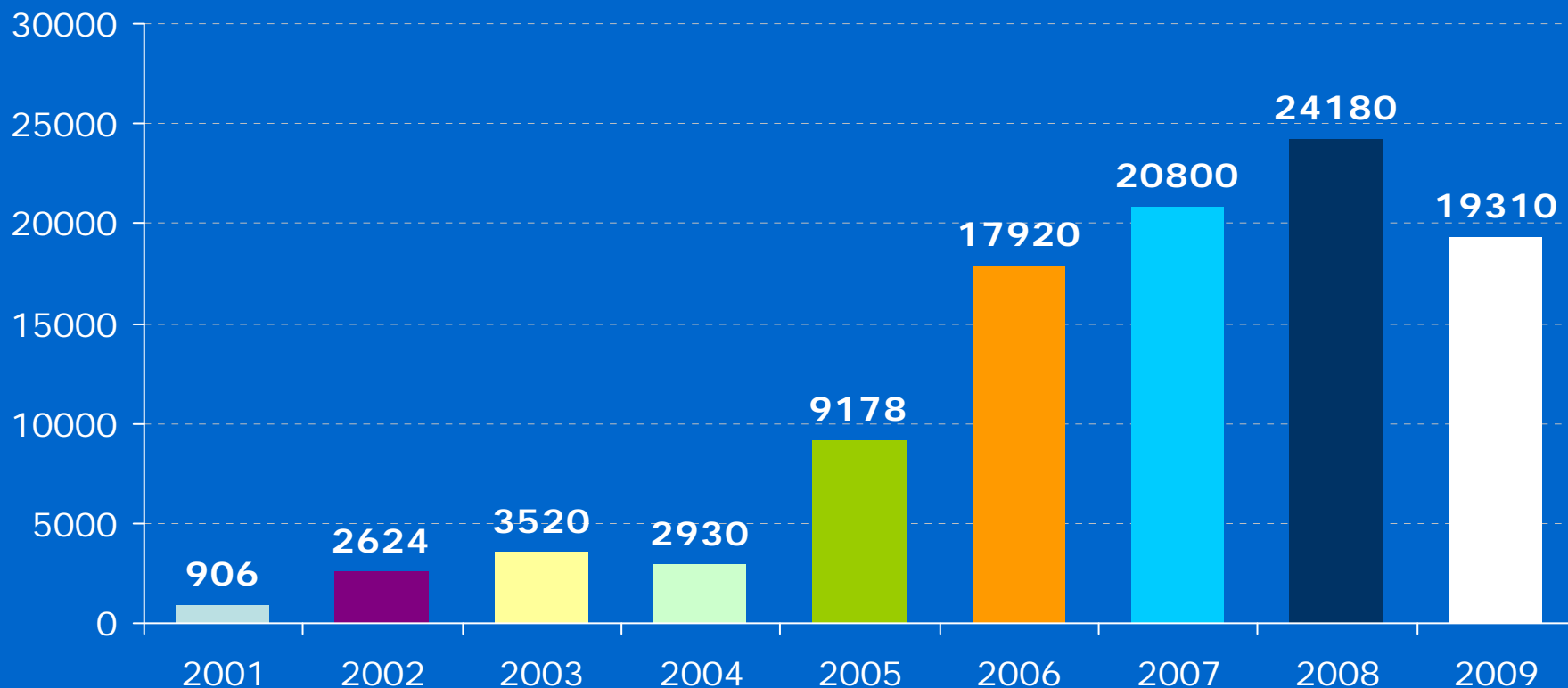

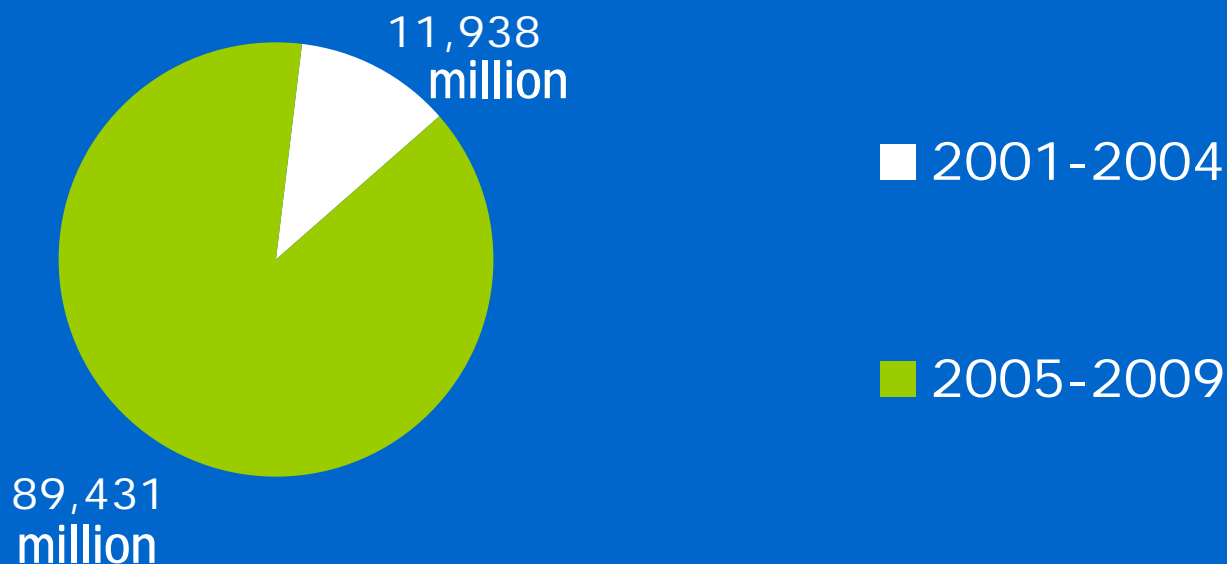

Gazprom's Investments in Russian Federation Regions Gasification in 2001-2009

Amount of investments,
RUB million



The investments totaled RUB **101.4** billion



- Continuing gasification of and gas supply to the Russian Federation regions
- Achieving the maximum economically viable level of gasification
- Meeting solvent gas demand
- Improving joint activities with the Russian Federation constituents' administrations in order to synchronize construction schedules for various facilities
- Gasification of Eastern Siberian and Far Eastern regions

- gasification of electric-powered boilers in the Hidrostroitel settlement for heat supply to the city of Bratsk in the Irkutsk Oblast

- startup of population centers gasification in the Adler District, Krasnodar Krai as part of the Olympic facilities preparation

Gazprom's obligations were fully met in 2009

- 178 inter-settlement gas pipelines construction was completed on schedule in 45 regions
- In addition, the startup complex comprising 11 inter-settlement gas pipelines of 7 facilities was completed ahead of schedule

Gazprom created conditions
for construction and connection of:

- 447 population centers
- 79.5 thousand households
- 579 rural boiler houses

Consumers were successfully prepared for gas supply in **23** regions

RUB 25 billion allocated for investment

- Gasification of strategic and top-priority facilities in Russia's Far Eastern and Southern regions
- Performance of Gazprom's obligations under the agreements made with the Russian Federation constituents
- Completion of facilities under construction
- Further construction operations to be completed in 2011 in certain regions
- Commencement of new facilities construction
- Engineering for future construction operations
- Elaboration (adjustment) of general schemes for gasification and gas supply

Total number of participants – **65** regions

- Gasification of CHPP-2 in Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky in Q3 2010
- Gasification of CHPP-1 in Yuzhno-Sakhalinsk in Q4 2010
- Gasification of Olympic facilities to be accomplished in 2011
- Gasification of CHPP-2 in Vladivostok and the Russky Island in Q3 2011
- Gasification of the Republic of Dagestan to be completed in 2010–2011
- Gasification of Nazran and Grozny

Karachayevo-Cherkessian Republic has been included in the Program

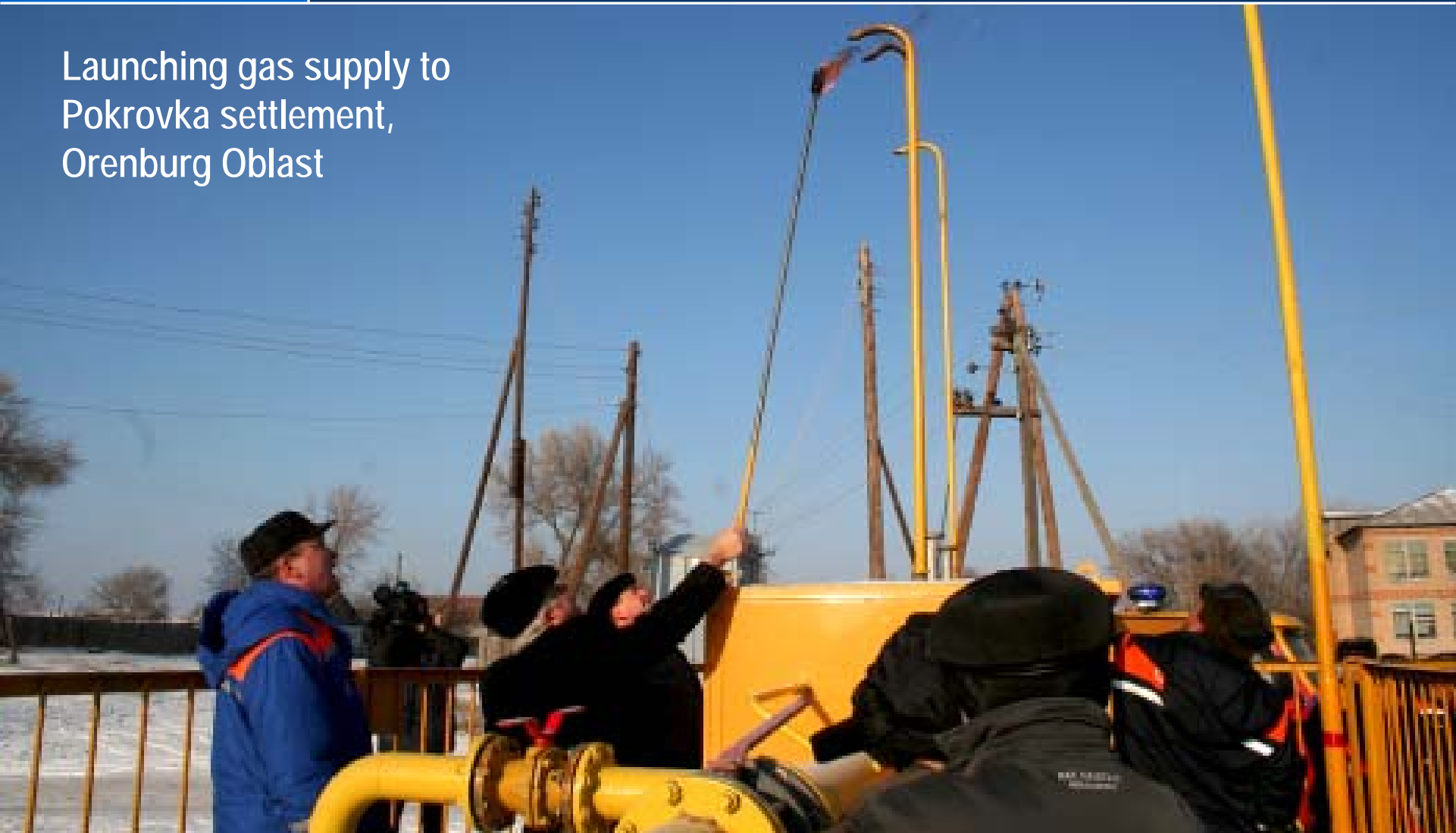
